Decision: 2004- 785

This is in reference to the **HPP 325** putter, received on October 13, 2004, which you submitted for an official ruling. This is a standard-length, flange-style aluminum putter with a triangular flange incorporating a furrow on the top for alignment.

Based upon your correspondence of November 19, 2004, you have indicated that the sample submitted is representative of production.

Please be advised that your putter conforms with the Rules of Golf.

This ruling applies only to the sample submitted and any clubs manufactured identical to it. This ruling does not apply if there is any change in the design, manufacture, material or construction of this particular club. If a club of similar design, with identical markings is acquired from any source and found to fail USGA standards, then conformance status of the club will be reviewed.

In advertisements of the **HPP 325** putter, you are authorized to make the statement: **“Conforms with USGA Rules.”** Use of the USGA seal or logo and/or statements such as “USGA Approved” or “USGA Tested” is prohibited.

We are retaining the sample as a record of this decision.

The USGA reserves the right to change the Rules and interpretations regulating equipment at any time.
